1. Any person or family in genuine need of emergency food supplies can be referred to the Foodbank.
2. Each referral has to be accompanied by a voucher (supplied to the referrers by the Foodbank), which the client presents at the Foodbank and will then receive supplies of dried, tinned and longlife food products to cover at least three days.
3. Self-referrals will not normally be accepted at the Foodbank.
4. Normally, a maximum of three vouchers can be presented by a client in a six month period. (There can be flexibility as a result of discussions between referrer and Foodbank)
5. An Information Pack will be sent to each agency that indicates their agreement to become a referrer.
6. Generally, clients will be required to collect their food supply from the Foodbank. However, in some specific and agreed circumstances, it may be possible for some referrers to hold a small supply of food packs. The Foodbank will still require each three-day food supply package to be accompanied or covered by a food voucher.
