1. After examining the literature used to promote the successful Fontmell Magna Neighbourhood Plan leading up to referendum it was concluded that we would produce a similar but less wordy document in order to highlight the following points:
 - To clearly summarise what the referendum is for and reasons to vote YES.
 - To explain how voting yes to the plan will give us the “Best chance of protecting and preserving Pimperne”
 - Explain where complete copies of the Neighbourhood Plan can be viewed.
 - Publicise and coffee morning/drop in session at the Village Hall on the Saturday preceding the vote.
2. Document to be printed prior to Christmas, but distributed between Christmas and the New Year, approx. around the 28th December onwards.
3. Jo Witherden suggested that all promotional material be run past the Electoral Team Services for approval prior to distribution to ensure that rules are not breached.
4. 20 Hard copies of the Neighbourhood Plan to be made available for public viewing at the Coffee morning/ drop in session at the Village Hall.
5. Posters to be made and posted around the Village as reminders to Villagers to save the referendum date in their diaries, also to raise awareness of the importance of the Neighbourhood Plan.
